~~ Strike Action - Wednesday 29th November ~^

As you may be aware from local media reports, the 5 main teaching unions have called a 'half day' strike on Wednesday 29th November. Where staff have elected to take lawful industrial action, schools and Boards of Governors, will have no choice but to take appropriate steps to ensure the health, safety, and wellbeing of all pupils. <u>Unfortunately, the school will be closed until 12.00 noon on that date.</u> We appreciate that this will cause some disruption to all parents, carers and guardians, but we would, however, ask for your understanding.

Please do not send your children in earlier as we will be unable to admit them.

School meals will be served, but must have been ordered by Sunday 26th November – we will be unable to accommodate any requests for school meals after this time. This includes Free School Meals – please order via SchoolMoney too.

**School transport** – at this time I have been assured that the school bus will run later in the morning to bring children to school for the later start.


Normal school times apply in the afternoon.

This is a dispute between teacher unions and the employers; it is not a dispute with the schools. This is not a strike just about teachers' pay. Teachers are taking strike action due to cuts to teachers' pay and the lack of adequate funding for schools which together are causing a crisis in Education.
