#### **CASHLESS PAYMENTS**


Please ensure that payments are up to date, especially school dinner bookings, as this can cause many problems with ensuring that dinners numbers and funds received must balance. Thank you.

#### **Contacting Staff & Collection of Pupils**

The Education Authority takes this into account when calculating the school budget with a deadline of 6<sup>th</sup> October.

Thank you to all those parents who came along to the first PTA meeting this year. It was lovely to see so many parents who are willing to give some of their time to raise funds and help out with events in the school! This year's activities will be aimed primarily at raising some funds to help with Literacy in the school – for example, we need to replenish many of our reading books and we are wishing to subscribe to an online reading programme, which will be of benefit to all pupils in developing and enhancing reading.

#### **Healthy Eating**

We strongly encourage children to make healthy choices and we need your support with this! Please try to send healthy snacks for break and lunch boxes. Please note that we do not allow any fizzy drinks or 'energy drinks' such as Powerade, Monster, Prime etc. we would also remind you that foods containing nuts should be avoided as we have some pupils with severe allergies.


#### Jack and the Beanstalk - M&M Productions
